## **Tenure-Track Nursing Instructor (2)**

Two full-time, tenure-track faculty positions in Nursing to begin Fall 2018. One position will be maternal-focused and the other will be medical/surgical focused. Responsible for classroom lecture of 15 contact hours per semester and clinical supervision of the students in the hospital setting. Requirements include a master's degree in nursing a State of Illinois Nursing License or be eligible to apply for one. Salary will be determined by education level and experience and will be between \$43,578 and \$73,459 annually. This position will be open until filled; however, applicants must have their materials submitted by Wednesday, April 18, 2018 to be considered during the initial review window.

## **Tenure-Track Radiography Instructor**

Full-time, tenure-track faculty position in Radiography to begin Fall 2018. The faculty/clinical coordinator position includes classroom lecture of 15 contact hours per semester and coordination of the students in the hospital setting. Requirements include a bachelor's degree; documentation of two years of clinical employment experience in the discipline; and a current registration in radiography with the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists with an unrestricted license in the state of Illinois. Salary will be determined by education level and experience and will be between \$41,399 and \$73,459 annually. This position will be open until filled; however, applicants must have their materials submitted by Wednesday, April 18, 2018 to be considered during the initial review window.
