Lincoln Land Community College is seeking qualified candidates to join our team of dedicated instructors and teach computer programming and networking courses. We have a full-time, tenure-track instructor opportunity as well as adjunct instructor opportunities. The computer networking faculty are working towards becoming a Center for Academic Excellence 2Y (CAE2Y) established by the National Security Agency (NSA) and the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), with the support of the National Science Foundation (NSF) and CyberWatch. Tenure-Track Computer Programming & Networking Instructor

Courses will be taught for students seeking the Computer Information Systems degree/certificate. This full-time, tenure-track instructor position will include classroom lecture of 15 contact hours per semester. Candidates must hold at least a bachelor's degree in computer science or a related field. Applicants with a master's degree are strongly preferred. Teaching load will consist of, but will not be limited to, Computer Programming Languages (i.e. Java and Visual Basic), Database development, Cisco® coursework, Networking Ethics and Security, Operating Systems, Help Desk and Servers. Salary will be determined by education level and experience and will be between \$41,399 and \$73,459 annually. This position will be open until filled; however, applicants must have their materials submitted by Sunday, May 20, 2018 to be considered during the initial review window.

Adjunct Networking Instructor

Part-time instructors will teach Cisco® Networking, Networking Ethics and Security, Operating systems, Help desk, and Servers courses at the colleges' main campus in Springfield. Candidates must possess a bachelor's degree in Computer Science or a related field. Prior teaching experience preferred. Experience with on-line teaching or the willingness to be trained to teach on-line is a plus.
