# TEEN JUSTICE CASE MANAGER

Millikin University seeks a Teen Justice Case Manager to directly monitor all program participants. The Case Manager directly assists participants with completion of service plans deemed appropriate by the Director. This is a self-directed position that requires keeping in regular contact with each participant and their family, conducts home visits, hosts face-to-face meetings, and works closely with local schools and community-based agencies to encourage the participant's success. Two or more years of experience in Juvenile Justice and/or case management is desirable. A Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice, Sociology, Psychology, Social Work, or related field is required, but candidates with a Master's Degree will be preferred.
